UnitedHealthcare Dental Medicare plans pay on PPO FEE SCHEDULES.

Most Medicare Advantage plans pay on a PPO fee schedule, even when the Medical ID card says HMO.

If you participate in the UnitedHealthcare Dental Dual Complete Network for AZ, FL, NY or PA, or the CA DHMO Network, then you will be paid on different fee schedules.
